VISITING SUPPORTERS PARKING

Queens Ground

Queens Ground car park has 100 – 120 spaces which is situated at the side of the Metrodome. Back of the west stand of the ground. This is a 2 minutes walk away from the ground. The cost of parking for cars is £3 and £10 for coaches.

The over spill car park is located on County Way. Signage from the M1 directs supporters to this location.

**DIRECTIONS FOR COACHES AND PRIVATE VEHICLES TRAVELLING
FROM THE NORTH**

Coaches and Private vehicles should travel via the M62 Motorway leading onto the M1. Leave the M1 at junction 37. After leaving the M1 at junction 37 head for Barnsley. Then follow the signs for Barnsley Football Club.

DIRECTIONS FOR COACHES AND PRIVATE VEHICLES TRAVELLING FROM THE SOUTH

Coaches and Private Vehicles should travel via the M1 Motorway leading onto the M1. Leave the M1 at junction 37. After leaving the M1 at junction 37 head for Barnsley. Then follow the signs for Barnsley Football Club.

Coaches and Private Vehicle travelling from the Humberside area travelling via the M62 motorway should exit the M62 onto the A1. Leaving the A1 onto the A635 Barnsley turn off. Then follow the signs for Barnsley. Continue on the A635 until you get to the traffic lights at the bottom of the hill passing the Ardsley House hotel on your left. At the traffic lights ensure that you are in the left-hand lane. Then follow the sign for Barnsley Football Club.

IF USING SAT NAV ALL COACH OPERATORS ARE ADVISED NOT TO INPUT GROVE STREET, THE ADDRESS OF THE CLUB, AS THIS WILL DIRECT THE COACHES INTO THE HEART OF THE ATTENDING HOME SUPPORTERS.

TRAFFIC COMMISSIONERS GUIDELINES

- Coaches are not to stop within ten miles of the venue either en-route or on departure from the venue unless prior permission has been obtained from the local police liaison officer.
- Coaches are not to arrive at the venue no earlier than two hours before and no later than one hour before the start of the event unless otherwise directed to by the police.
- Coaches are not to set down or load passengers at any unauthorised locations without prior permission of the police.
- Coaches must leave the venue within one hour of the finish of the event.
- Coaches must not carry any intoxicating liquor and operators and drivers must take all the reasonable steps to ensure that this is adhered to.

ANY COACH OPERATOR OR DRIVER WHO BREACHES THESE GUIDELINES OR THE OBLIGATORY FORBIDDING OF ALCOHOL ON COACHES WILL BE REPORTED FOR ANY OFFENCES DISCLOSED. THE TRAFFIC COMMISSIONERS WILL BE INFORMED OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES.
