

## **TRAVEL DIRECTIONS TO DONCASTER**

**COACHES** Visiting supporter's coaches will be required to rendezvous at **Junction 3** of the M18 at 1330hrs (for a 1500hr KO) and 1830hrs (for a 1945hr KO) where they will be given a motorcycle escort to the ground.

Coaches can now park at the stadium at a cost of £20. Mini buses £10 and private cars £5.

### **Directions.**

Doncaster is centrally placed in the country and is well served by the motorway network. It is easy to find.

Post code for the stadium is DN4 5JW.

From the M62 (heading East) drive south on the M1 to Junction 32 (M18) and travel to Junction 3. Alternatively continue on the M62 to the A1 and travel South to junction 36 (Doncaster) or junction 35 (M18) and travel east for 1 mile to junction 3.

From the M62 (heading West) continue into the M18 and travel to junction 3. Similarly from the M180 travel West from junction 1 (M18/M180) and travel to junction 3.

From the M1 travelling north, exit at junction 32 north (M18) and travel to junction 3.

From the A1 exit at junction 35 and head east onto the M18 and exit at Junction 3.

From junction 3 follow the road to the SECOND roundabout and go straight on, turning left at the next roundabout. The stadium is then on the right hand side.

Parking around the stadium is at a premium.

## **TRAFFIC COMMISSIONERS GUIDELINES.**

- Coaches are not to stop within ten miles of the venue either en-route or on departure from the venue unless prior permission has been obtained from the local police liaison officer.
- Coaches are not to arrive at the venue no earlier than two hours before and no later than one hour before the start of the event unless otherwise directed to by the police.
- Coaches are not to set down or load passengers at any unauthorised locations without prior permission of the police.
- Coaches must leave the venue within one hour of the finish of the event.
- Coaches must not carry any intoxicating liquor and operators and drivers must take all the reasonable steps to ensure that this is adhered to.

**ANY COACH OPERATOR OR DRIVER WHO BREACHES THESE GUIDELINES OR THE OBLIGATORY FORBIDDING OF ALCOHOL ON COACHES WILL BE REPORTED FOR ANY OFFENCES DISCLOSED. THE TRAFFIC COMMISSIONERS WILL BE INFORMED OF THE CIRCUMSTANCES.**
