



Police Travel Instructions Reading FC



The designated route for visiting supporters will be via M4 Junction 11, signposts to Madejski Stadium complex start at this location. The following points should be brought to the attention of coach operators and supporters associations connected with your Club.

(i) **Visiting supporters' coaches will not be escorted to and from the Stadium. All Coaches must not arrive earlier than one and a half hours prior to kick off and not stop within 10 miles of Reading either pre or post match. From one hour before kick off the stadium will close the stadium roads and coaches will be parked off site and as directed by stewards, ANY NON COMPLIANCE OF THESE INSTRUCTIONS WILL RESULT IN DRIVERS / COMPANIES BEING REPORTED.**

(ii) Coach drivers should leave the M4 at Junction 11, enter the roundabout and take the exit signposted Madejski Stadium and make their own way to the ground. At the stadium coaches will be received and parked on club property.

(iii) Visiting supporters travelling by private transportation are requested to arrive at the Ground allowing plenty of time. There are no cash sales on the day at turnstiles and tickets should be purchased from ticket booths or from the allocation given to that particular club,

(v) On arrival at the Ground, ALL visiting supporters should enter the RED STAND (South) Gate 9 and 10, after the pre purchase tickets (if available) from kiosks at the Stadium. Licensed Bars and various food outlets will be available on the concourse inside the stadium. For certain matches alcohol will not be available.

(vi) Visiting supporters are not normally kept back after the final whistle, but are allowed to leave immediately. Coaches will be drawn up at the exit gates to receive fans as they leave and must be ready to leave 15 minutes after full time. Coach drivers will be asked to inform all passengers of this requirement. These coaches will make their own way back to the M4.
