

SHEFFIELD WEDNESDAY DIRECTIONS TO HILLSBOROUGH

COACH OPERATORS

In relation to football matches, coach operators are requested to follow the below instructions.

All visiting supporters' coaches should arrive at the rendezvous point between 1 to 2 hours prior to the kick off time.

The rendezvous point is at Junction 36 (Northbound) of M1 Motorway which is it's junction with the A61.

Exiting the motorway follow signs for Sheffield A61, immediately on the left is a lay-by where coaches will be met by South Yorkshire Police. South Yorkshire Police Traffic dept will provide motorcycles for escort duties. Coaches will be taken directly to the ground for passengers to alight.

The coaches will then be taken away to a designated parking area and brought back to the ground after the game. Coach drivers are asked to remain with their vehicles.

Maps giving the location of the Motorway route to the stadium and the coach parking area are enclosed.

All coaches will be searched on arrival at the ground. Coach operators are reminded to make themselves aware of the current legislation regarding alcohol and drunkenness and their commitment to ensuring that fans do not arrive in a drunken condition. South Yorkshire Police will have no hesitation in reporting offending firms to the Traffic Commissioner if offences are disclosed.

At the conclusion of the fixture coaches will be provided with a escort away from the stadium and are asked to ensure their passengers return to their respective coaches immediately the game finishes otherwise the convoy is delayed.
